Rules and conditions for the V.R.Z.A. certificates.

WORKED ALL PROVINCES CERTIFICATE "W.A.P." (full color)

Demands: QSL's of each of the twelve Netherlands Provinces:

Groningen (GR), Friesland (FR), Drente (DR), Overijsel (OV), Gelderland (GD), Flevoland (FL), Utrecht (UT), Noord Holland (NH), Zuid Holland (ZH), Zeeland (ZL), Noord Brabant (NB), and Limburg (LB). The club-stations PI4VRZ/A and PI4CQP/A may be used as a joker or substitute for missing province.

DIVISIONAL CERTIFICATE (full color)

Demands: QSL's of contacts with V.R.Z.A.-clubstations (from november 23, 1986)

HF inside Europe 8 stations Outside Europe 4 stations VHF and higher inside Europe 4 stations Outside Europe 2 stations

Valid are:

LOCATOR-CERTIFICATE (full Color)

Demands: Only QSL's of VHF (2 mtr. and higher) contacts are valid for this certificate. Basic certificate demands 10

different locator-squares (f.e. JO23, JO33, IO01, IO21 a.s.o.) "Golden" seals for 20, 30, 40, 50, 75 and 100

different locator-squares are available.

WORKED ALL CONTINENTS "W.A.C."

Demands: QSL's of each of the six continents:

Africa, Asia, Europe, North America, South America and Oceania.

WORKED VHF PREFIXES CERTIFICATE "W.P.F.X."

Demands: QSL's of VHF contacts with different prefixes. Basic certificate for 30 prefixes. Seals for 50,

75, 100 and 150 prefixes.

"VHF-50 CERTIFICATE VHF-50"

Demands: QSL's of VHF (2 mtr. and higher) contacts with 25 stations over at least 40 km (25 miles) AND 25 stations over

at least 400 km (250 miles) distance.

FOR ALL V.R.Z.A.-CERTIFICATES THE FOLLOWING GENERAL RULES APPLY:

Also available for SWL's;

- Application should contain calls, date, band, mode of claimed contacts, for the LOCATOR-Certificate the squares alphabetic, VHF-50 locator and QTH, WPFX prefixes in alphabetic order, WAP provinces as mentioned;
- Contacts made via repeaters (excluding DIVISIONAL CERTIFICATE) are NOT VALID for VHF and higher certificates, contacts made via OSCAR's etc. are only valid if all claimed contacts for the certificates are made via satellite;
- All contacts should be made from the same QTH (or within 25 miles);
- Fee for each certificate is 6 IRC's, US \$6,00 or € 5,00
- Fee for each seal-application is SAE + US \$1,00 or 1 IRC or €1,00
- Do not send QSL's, a GCR-list, signed by two other licensed amateurs is enough, in case of any doubts the award manager is allowed to ask for the QSL's of the claimed contacts;
